

# Dual Music Box

Dual Music box is a library of 2 music boxes and other sounds. These 3 layers can be mixed together to make a wide variety of music box timbres. The 1st layer is the Victorian Music Box, the 2nd is a tiny, bright music box and the 3rd varies between patches, for example glockenspiel/ synth strings/ string pluck. If you enjoyed the free Victorian Music box, but want more options for realism and sound design, then Dual Music box is perfect for you.

## INSTRUMENT PAGE

This is the patch name. The word after the first dash tells you what layer 3 will be. E.g. 'Original'.

Randomises the start time of each note.

Volume of a tiny music box samples.

Volume of Victorian Music Box.

Volume of extra morphed layer. This varies for each patch.



21 unusual convolution reverb impulses.

Displays the value of the currently selected control.

Up and down arrows allow you to pitch each layer up or down octaves. The small number at the bottom of the control shows the current octave.

Low and high eq.

# EFFECTS PAGE

Select delay preset.

Time for delay to be synced to.

If free is selected, then this control changes the time.

To set these to default (0dB), hold ctrl and click.

Toggle between Delay/Reverb page and Rotator/Distortion page.

Select reverb preset.

Value of current control.



To completely bypass the effect, turn the wet/mix/drive down to the off position.

To set these to default (0dB), hold ctrl and click.
